

NATIONAL COCOA AND COFFEE BOARD

The **National Cocoa and Coffee Board** (NCCB) was created by Decree No. 91/271 of 12 June 1991, and amended and supplemented by Decree No. 97/141 of 25 August 1997. It is a public entity with financial autonomy.



Mission

Contribute effectively and efficiently in the fight against poverty in rural areas by investing efforts, energy, and capacity building of all stakeholders and promoting the sustainability of the Cocoa and Coffee sectors.



Vision

Regulate and supervise cocoa and coffee related activities from farm-gate to export.

Activities



- » Control and guarantee the quality of cocoa and coffee ;
- » Monitor export statistics along with the cocoa and coffee trading seasons;
- » Defend and promote the image of Cameroon origin ;
- » Streamline and valorize the trading of produce, their derivatives;
- » Disseminate information and guarantee the smooth functioning of all activities in the sector;
- » Monitor international cocoa and coffee agreements as well as representing Cameroon in international cocoa and coffee organizations.

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BALANCE-SHEET OF THE 2021-2022 SEASON

As in previous seasons, the 2021/2022 Cocoa season ran from August 1, 2021 to July 15, 2022. The balancesheet is presented as follows:

- Domestic Traded volume stood at **295 163 506 kg** up from **292 471 465 kg**, recorded last season. This indicates an increase of **2 692 041 Kg** in absolute terms, and **0,91%** in relative terms.
- A total of **86 850 663 kg** was processed locally, compared to the **62 425 288 kg**, of last season. Explicitly, Local processing increased by **24 425 375 Kg**, therefore, by 28,12%.
- **Highest Price per Kilogramme : 1290 FCFA**, up from the **1210 FCFA/Kg** observed last season.
- **Lowest Price per Kilogramme : 750FCFA**, an improvement from the **700 FCFA/Kg** of last season..
- **Stockpile** for the 2021/2022 season : **12 599 942 Kg**



II- INTERNAL TRADE

- PURCHASES

319 131 091 kg bought by exporters and independent buyers ;

- Purchases were carried out in **08 Regions** of Cameroon.
- The **Centre** Region emerged on top (**45,39%**) trailed by the **Southwest** Region (**31,18 %**) and the **Littoral** Region (**11,10 %**).



- QUALITY

218 992 895 KG was checked and cleared for export :

- An overwhelming majority of cocoa was exported as **Grade 2**, and **5,40%** of cocoa beans exported **Grade 1**.

- EXPORTS

- 228 920 543 kg** worth of contracts were approved;
- 217 107 737 kg** of cocoa beans was exported ;
- 03 Operators** accounted for **65,66%** of total exports: They are; **TELCAR (36,09%)**, **USICAM (19,61%)**, **SBET (9,96%)** ;
- Export destinations : Cameroon Cocoa was shipped to **16 countries** and arrived at **24 ports** across **03 continents**; **Europe, Asia** and **North America**;
- Money supply (in FOB Value) : **288 746 495 869 FCFA**.

c - The combined volume of processed cocoa for the 2021/2022 season stood at **86 922 496 Kg**

IV- PRICES

Farm-gate prices : Maximum Price **1290 FCFA/Kg**, and minimum price **750 FCFA/Kg**.

- a - The average FOB price per contracts maturity periods from August 2021, to July 2022 ranged from **1303 FCFA/Kg** to **1349 FCFA/Kg** ;
- b - The average FOB price stood at **1333 FCFA/KG** ;
- c - The average price paid to farmers ranged between **58,28%** and **94,79%** of the FOB price.
